- Submit up to 3 digital images on CD or by
email. Image of artwork only, no frames or
backgrounds.
- A non-refundable fee of \$15 must accom-
pany the entry form and images. Make

ety, Inc.
- Digital images must be submitted in jpeg
format and be at least 300dpi resolution.
- CD– Put artists name on CD, title of work
will be the file name. Include a self-
stamped postage paid CD envelope for re-
turn of CD.
- Email submission must include artist name,
phone number, title of work. Mail entry
form and fee separately.

Olivia Olsen

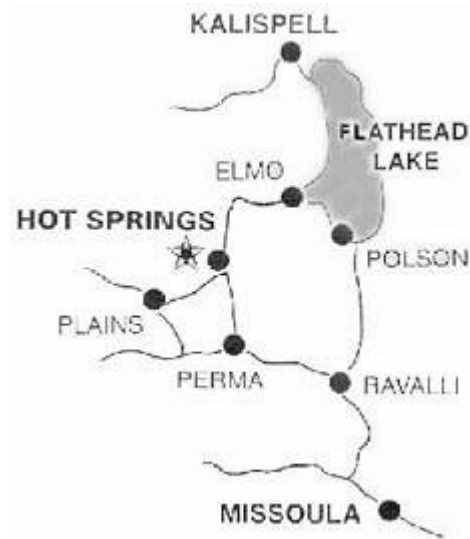

Today there are five different soaking pools to experience and every year thousands of people find relief from stress, soothe their aches and pains, meet old friends and make new ones, while soaking in our mineral waters.
